RE: June 1st, 2018 TSCA Title VI Certification Deadline

To whom it may concern:

Plummer Forest Products (PFP), the manufacturer of Enstron Particleboard is working diligently to obtain a certification of compliance to EPA TSCA Title VI. Currently PFP is CARB and TSCA Title VI compliant because of the reciprocity position the EPA has granted.

All Enstron Particleboard is exempt from the California CARB Phase II. Our exemption number is N-17-002.

The federal register, volume 83, No. 65 dated Wednesday, April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2018 Section III Current Status of Compliance Dates, states the following:

By June 1, 2018 and until March 22, 2019, regulated composite wood panels and finished products containing such composite wood panels that are manufactured (in the United States) or imported (into the United States) must be certified as compliant with either the TSCA Title VI or the California Air Resources Board (CARB) Airborne Toxic Control Measures (ATCM) Phase II emission standards, which are set at identical levels, by a third-party certifier (TPC) approved by CARB and recognized by EPA. Previously, these products were required to be TSCA Title VI compliant by December 12, 2018. Until March 22, 2019, regulated products certified as compliant with the CARB ATCM Phase II emission standards must be labeled as compliant either with TSCA Title VI or the CARB ATCM Phase II emission standards.

As you can see in the standard, Enstron particleboard carrying the CARB ATCM certification will suffice until March 22, 2019. PFP is currently working with the Composite Panel Association (CPA) as our third party certifier for TSCA Title VI. As soon as CPA is able to issue PFP a document of compliance to TSCA Title VI we will forward it to our customers. The CPA expects this process to be complete by the end of summer.
